- 6) What do you think people need from a drug and alcohol service?
- 7) In what ways do you think drug and alcohol services could be improved in future?

Definitions –

Central Lancs – *this is the term used to describe the Preston, Chorley, South Ribble and West Lancs areas.*

Drug and alcohol services – *services that provide support and treatment for individual people who use or misuse drugs and/or alcohol.*
